ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED

- Items that have been opened or partially-used
- Products not in their original packaging

- Products that have been contaminated
- Alcoholic beverages or energy drinks of any kind
- Items in glass jars
- Canned items more than 3 years old
- Any kind of medicine
- Expired baby food or baby food not in a plastic container
