Frequently Asked Questions

What is the cost?

The cost is \$80 per person.

Is there a limit to the number of people I can sign up?

For any registration, there must be at least one adult for every 10 children.

What should I bring with me to the "Overnights at Frost Science" program?

To make your experience a pleasant one, the following items are suggested:

- A pillow
- A sleeping bag
- Comfortable shoes and clothing
- Appropriate sleep attire for a shared space (shorts/t-shirts, pajamas, sweats, etc.)

Optional items include:

- Ear plugs
- Non-inflatable sleeping mat (yoga mat or a camping mat)

Where do we park?

All "Overnights at Frost Science" guests may park in the museum's garage for a flat rate. Because of limited space, we strongly suggest carpooling, if possible.

Where do we check in?

After you have parked, bring your materials up our ramp and check in at the registration table near the membership office. There, you can leave all your belongings. Frost Science will bring them up to the Knight Learning Center before your program officially begins.

What happens if we are late?

We will try to accommodate all late arrivals up to 7:15 p.m. (during the "Overnights at Frost Science" group orientation). After that point, we can no longer accept any guests. This means that all registration fees will be forfeited.

Can we bring air mattresses?

Air mattresses are strictly prohibited due to spacing issues. That being said, we strongly encourage all guests to bring their own comfortable sleeping bags and pillows.

Are we allowed to bring our own food and beverages into the museum?

Outside food and beverages are strictly prohibited at Frost Science. We will, however, offer our overnight quests dinner, breakfast and snacks.

Where do we sleep?

Frost Science has several designated sleeping quarters within the museum, ranging from exhibit galleries to classrooms (all of which are locked and monitored by our safety personnel). Locations will be determined by the theme of the overnight stay and confirmed via your registration invoice.

Is it possible to leave early?

Yes, overnight guests are allowed to leave early but all rates remain the same.

Will the gift shop remain open?

Our gift shop will remain open for a specially designated period, which will allow you time to purchase a memento of the experience.

What exhibition galleries are available at the museum?

Exhibition galleries available to guests will be determined by the theme of your "Overnights at Frost Science" experience.

How accessible/inclusive is your museum and the "Overnights at Frost Science" program?

Our entire museum and its programs are designed for all guests to enjoy. That being said, if any one in your group has a special need that you feel we should be aware of, please share any/all concerns with our reservations team and we will do our best to accommodate.

Is there an age requirement for chaperones?

Yes, all designated chaperones must be 21 or older. Under no circumstances can this rule be modified.

Where do we store our belongings?

When you arrive, items such as sleeping bags and change of clothes will be stored near your sleeping area. Please keep purses or any other valuables with you during your visit.

Can we register the day of?

No, we will not accept any reservations the day of. Final reservations must be secured up to seven days in advance. Beyond that point, all monies will be forfeited.
